Bachelor of Arts Programme Regulations:

1. Courses in a minimum of three subjects listed in the BA Schedule.
2. At least 180 points (12 courses) must be above Stage I.
3. Up to 30 points (2 courses) may be taken from outside the Faculty.
4. 30 points (2 courses) must be taken from the appropriate General Education Schedules for BA students.
5. At least 90 points (6 courses) must be at Stage III.
6. Majors must include at least 45 points (3 courses) at Stage III.

It is the student's responsibility to check that the final programme complies with University Regulations. The Faculty of Arts is the final authority on all BA regulations.
