Coffee Mornings



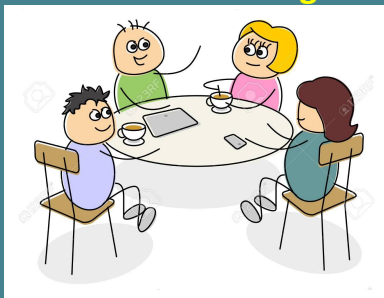
We are celebrating our 4th birthday this month. There will be cake along with free coffee at this month's coffee morning:

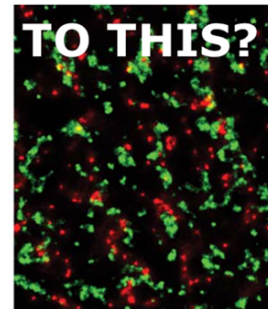
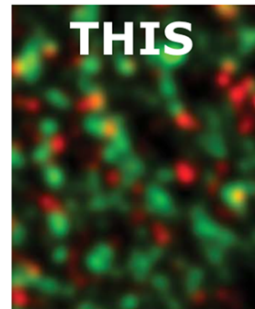
