Entry requirements

Academic: 211/985 bachelors degree in a business or non-business field with at least a 75 percent average. Non-211/985 bachelors degree in a business or non-business field with at least an 80-85 percent average. No work experience required.

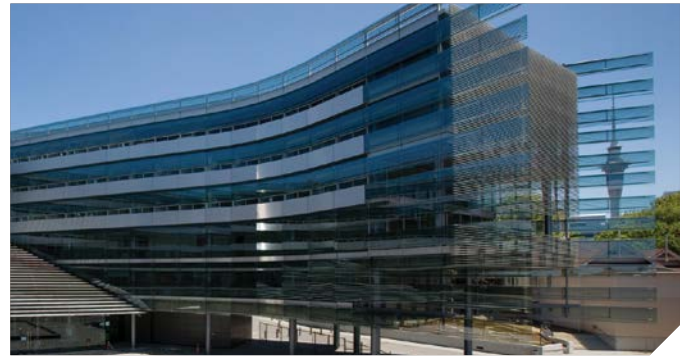
