Entry requirements

Academic: To gain entry you will need to have completed a bachelors degree from a recognised university with the equivalent of at least a New Zealand B grade average. No work experience required.

English language: International students must achieve an academic IELTS overall score of 6.5, all bands 6.0 or better or the TOEFL equivalent.
