



Strategic Supply Chain Management Programme 2020 – Application Process

The right mix of participants is critical in creating an environment where experiences and perspectives are exchanged. Participants for the programme will be selected based on meeting the criteria below:

- Currently be in a role that reports to a GM or senior supply chain manager, procurement, logistics or similar role.
- Have a minimum of five years' supply chain related experience
- Have been identified as having potential to progress to GM or equivalent role within the next five – seven years

Programme Location, Times and Dates

The first Module will be delivered online then subsequent modules will be based at the University of Auckland Business School, 12 Grafton Road, Auckland. This is an intensive programme. It is expected that Applicants will attend the following:

Participant Fee :

The fee for participation in the programme is \$12,000 + GST. This includes attendance at all of the modules incl daily catering, parking, travel to site visits, mentoring support for projects, materials and required reading.
