

**Expression of Interest (EOI) to exhibit at the
MaDE2020 Student Innovation Showcase**

***Happy Hour: Let's all talk together – students,
industry, and academics***

**Monday 25 May 2020, 5.30-7pm
(Set-up from 5pm; Pack down by 7.30pm)**

This Pop-up one hour exhibition provides students with the opportunity to explain their work through physical samples and to strike up conversations with and gain feedback from industry, academics and fellow student delegates.

In submitting your work for the exhibition you will need to bring your demonstration, sample or exhibit to the Conference and be able to set it up on a table within 30 minutes at 5pm on Monday 25 May 2020 and remove it by 7.30pm at the latest (some floor mounted exhibits may be allowed).

Please note:

- You **MUST** download this EOI form, **SAVE** it to your desktop, **RE-OPEN** your saved version, **FILL** both **SECTION A** and **SECTION B** of the EOI form, and then submit it using the **SUBMIT** button at the top of the EOI form.
- The information supplied in **SECTION A** will be displayed as an exhibition label.
- **ALL** fields are compulsory, including sending **AN IMAGE** (jpeg file with 300 dpi resolution) of your demonstration/sample/exhibit for inclusion on the exhibition label **BY SEPARATE EMAIL**.
- Apart from the image you supply for the label, all other presentation material, images and videos should be presented to your audience on your own device (phone, iPad or laptop). No power will be provided for these devices.
- The deadline for submissions is strictly 30 March 2020.
- The MaDE2020 Organising Committee will accept a maximum of 20 submissions for display during *Happy Hour* on 25 May 2020.
- If your EOI submission is accepted, registration and attendance at MaDE2020 is a prerequisite for all exhibitors during *Happy Hour*. You will need to register before 5 April 2020 to take advantage of our Early Bird pricing. Standard registration closes on 15 May 2020. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to register.
