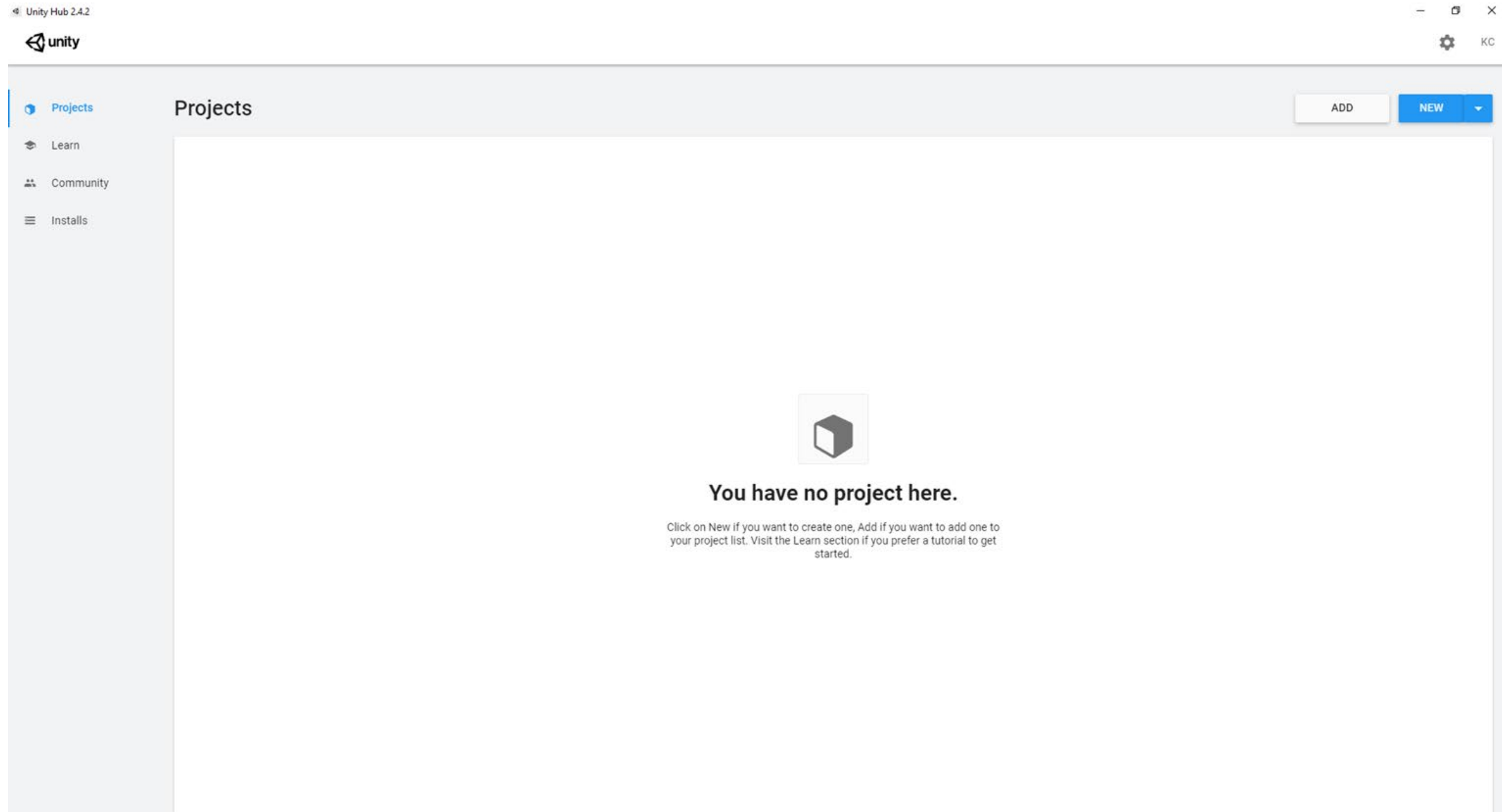


You don't have to pick a micro game - it's a filler video for you to watch while Unity is installing

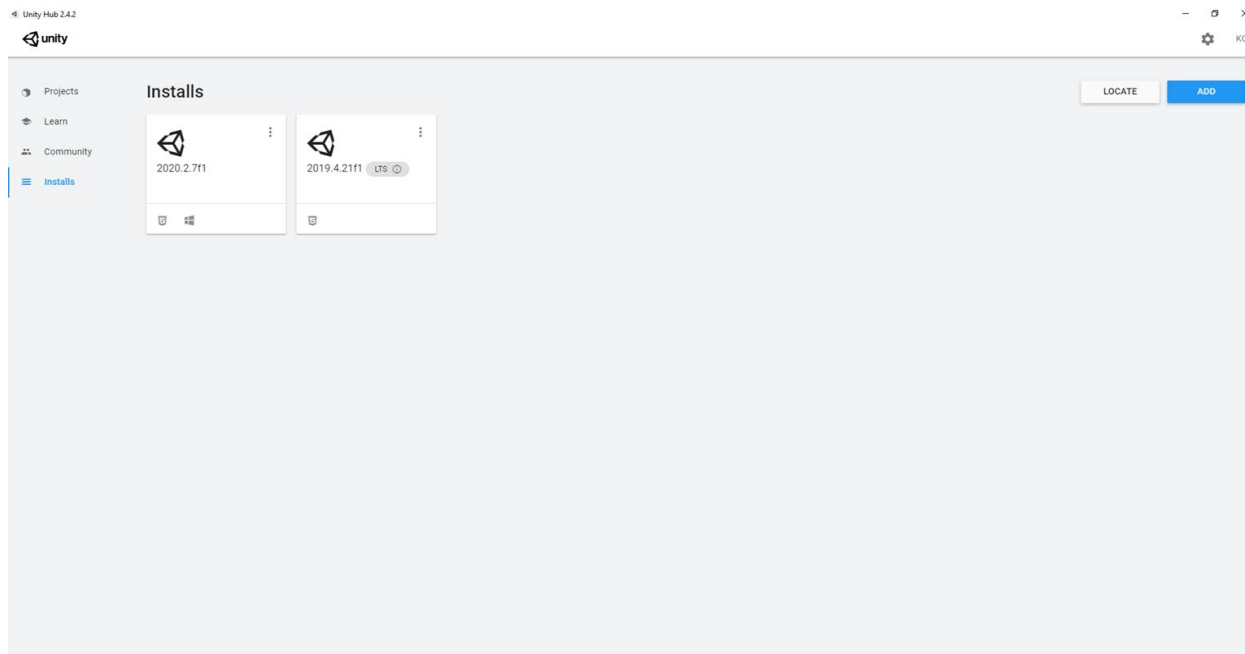


Opening Unity Hub should look like this

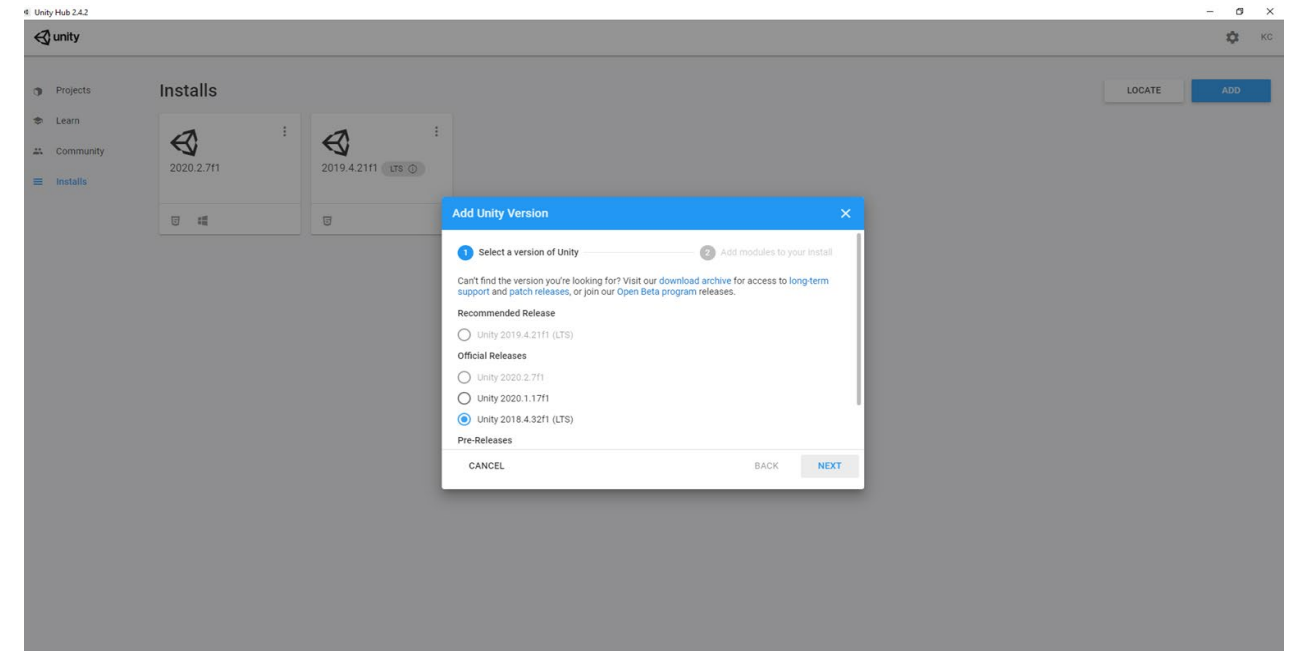
