We believe that in conjunction with our Pastoral Care Program, the students, staff and contractors be made aware of, and implement the issues of UV Protection.

We believe in the definitions provided by the CSH&W SA Policy: Protection from Heat and UV Radiation Procedure.

We believe these requirements relate to all aspects of school life, to extra-curricular sports, excursions and outings.

STRATEGIES

At Holy Family Catholic School:

- We encourage use of a hat at play.
- We supply and encourage use of 30+ factor sunscreen.
- We provide shaded areas in most areas around the school.
- We encourage use of protective clothing, especially hats.
- We provide PD for all staff on sun-safe issues, and always model these for staff, and
- We follow the directions of the Anti-Cancer Foundation.

WARM OR WET WEATHER

Weather is monitored throughout the day and on days of warm weather, the school has the following procedures in place.

When the temperature on the Bureau of Meteorology website advises 35°C or wet weather, students remain inside and supervision is shared between teaching partners and the leadership team.
