Reminders

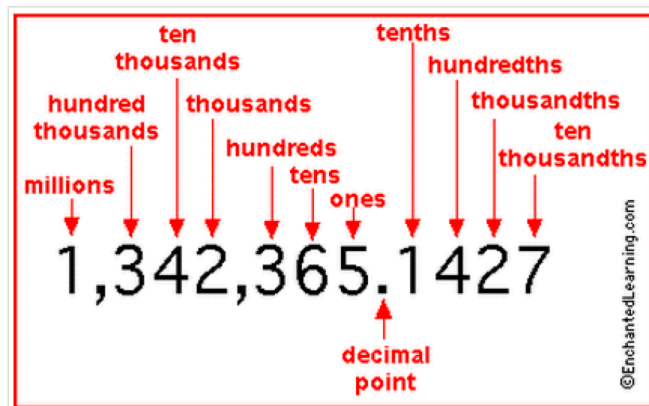
Continue to complete your 30 minutes of reading per day. Record your reading in a reading log of your choice. By now you should have at least approximately 12 hours of reading recorded.
