- Decide between Government (apply through PS) & Non-government (apply personally)
- Exceptions – Siblings claim
  - Curriculum Grounds (applications on websites)
  - Compassionate Grounds
  - Integration/special school

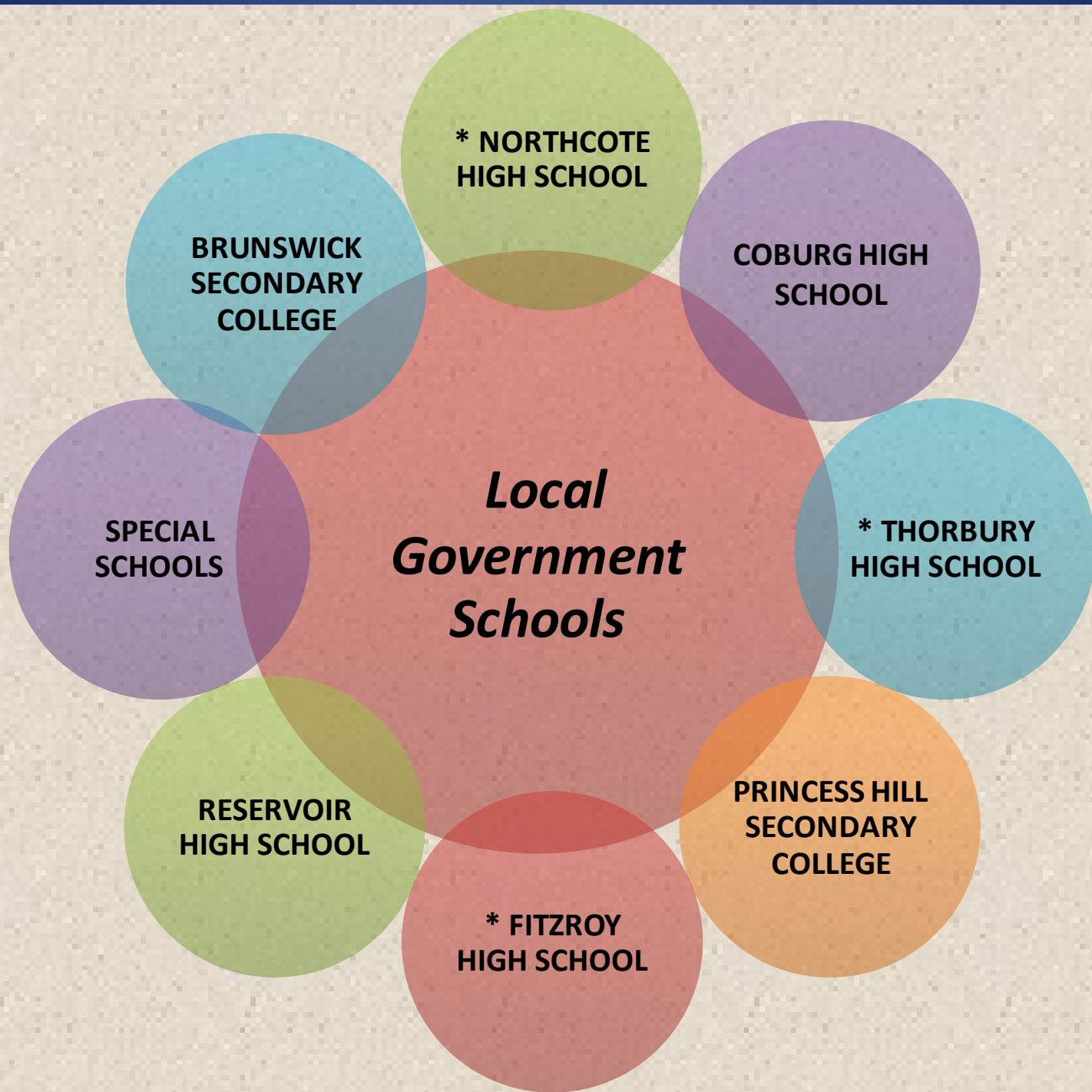
