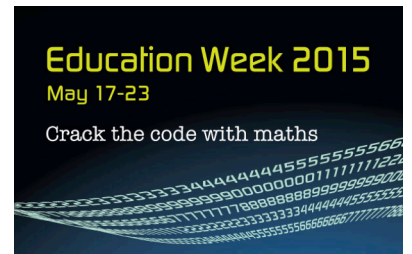


Sudoku - Can you solve this Sudoku puzzle?

A Sudoku is a grid with 9 squares across and 9 squares down. The lines of squares running horizontally are called rows, and the lines running vertically are called columns. The grid is further divided by the darker lines into nine 3 x 3 square 'boxes'. Some of the squares already have numbers in them.



Your task is to fill in the blank squares. There's only one rule:

- Each row, column and box must end up containing all of the numbers from 1 to 9.

This rule has an important side-effect, which is the basis of all solving techniques:

- Each number can only appear once in a row, column or box. Good luck
