### SCHOOL ENTRY & EXIT POINTS

Foundation students use the small front gate

Grade 1 -2 students use the large driveway gate

**Pick-up will be staggered to assist with social distancing**

Families with surnames between **A – G** pick up their children at 3.10 pm

Families with surnames between **H – Z** pick up their children at 3.30 pm

Staff members will wait with students at the front gates, or at the undercover area if it is raining.

Parents should line up on the nature strip at the front of the school, at the relevant gate noting the yellow markings 1.5 metres apart, and staff will bring children to the gate

To ensure this system works smoothly for everyone, please the school if you are running late.

We understand some families may have commitments which mean these times are not possible. If so, please contact me as soon as possible to arrange a suitable weekly time.
