Updates to restrictions for school events such as the End of Year Concert & Gr. 6 Dinner

CONCERT - NEW DATE – MONDAY DECEMBER 14th – 5.30 pm

With the easing of restrictions for schools, school families will be able to attend the End of Year Concert. The date has been changed to Monday December 14th, starting time 5.30 pm

The Concert will be held behind the Foundation – grade 2 school buildings, with families being able to be on the oval, in their 'family space' to ensure social distancing between families.

Please note family groups need to be of a size to fit in the 4 square metre space per family

- BYO Picnic blankets, chairs and a picnic if you wish

-Families will not be able to share food; or mingle with other families after the concert and are asked to leave promptly after the Concert finishes to comply with Department requirements

-Face masks must be worn indoors by people aged 12 years and over (other than Primary aged students), unless an exemption applies. Masks are required outdoors if social distancing of 1.5 metres cannot be maintained

-The visitor book will need to be filled in by all attending

-The Raffle will drawn at the concert

-There won't be a Christmas 'component' or supper this year.
