



Reading Comprehension

Who were the main characters in the story? Can you describe what they looked like? Can you describe their personality?

How did the characters feel when the problem was solved? How do you know they felt that way? Find the evidence in the story.

What was the setting in this story? Can you explain what it looked like? Why would people like/not like to go to this place?

How did the characters feel about each other? What makes you think that?

What was the problem in this story? What caused it to happen?

What did the characters learn at the end of the story? How do you know they learnt that?

What did they do to solve the problem? Is there another way the characters could have solved the problem?

Was there anything strange that happened in this story that didn't make sense? Show me that part of the story. (*Discuss why it didn't make sense.*)



Reading Comprehension

Are there any words that you didn't understand? Can you show me them.

What do you think they mean? Does that meaning make sense in this sentence?

(Let them know if they have the meaning correct or discuss the true meaning of the word). Can you reuse the word in a new sentence?

Can you find a part of the story where the author uses adjectives to describe a character or setting? Can you draw a picture that matches the description.

Can you think of another time or place where the same problem could have happened?

Is this a good title for this story? Why or why not? Can you think of another title for this story that would also make sense?

What was the most important part of the story? Why was it more important than everything else that happened?

Can you find a part of the story that is similar to something you have done, seen or heard of in real life? Explain how it is similar and how it is different.

Why do you think the author wrote this story? *(P.I.E. to Persuade, Inform or Entertain?)*
