1. Go to www.photosforclass.com



2. Type the **name** of the image you're looking for in the **search bar** (eg. tiger, tennis, volcano). Press **find photos**.

3. Look at your choices and click on **download** under the image you like.

4. A box will **pop up** asking where on your computer you want to save your image (eg. **Pictures**). Next to **file name** type a name that describes the picture (eg. tiger). Press **save**.

5. Your image will appear with a caption underneath with attribution information.



1. Go to openclipart.org



2. Type the **name** of the image you're looking for in the **search bar** (eg. Earth, clock, piano). Press 

3. Find the image you want and **click on the title or the picture**. A new page will load.



4. You will see different options to save the file. You might want to choose one of these (eg. **medium image**).
