Adam hadn't made a single sound. I looked at him to see if he was alright. His face was green and he had a look of terror in his eyes. I couldn't help but giggle.

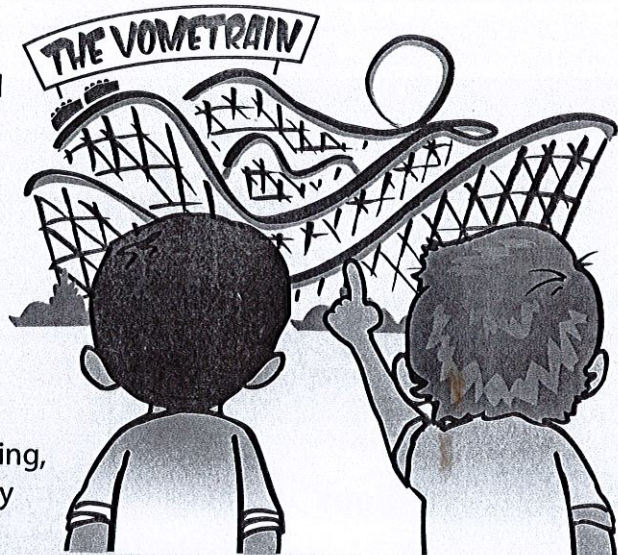
As the roller-coaster went through the loop-the-loop at top speed, I felt some liquid hit my arm. 'Was it raining?' I wondered.
