

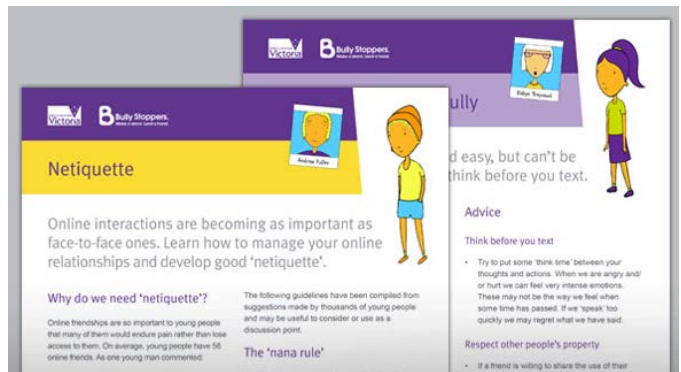

### Interactive Learning Modules
