

Flex Term Media Studios (November-December 2021)

We are pleased to announce preliminary details of the 2021 Flex Term Media Studio courses. Each studio course gains 24 points credit and is run intensively over six weeks (i.e. double the usual weekly contact hours) in mixed course groups:

Who needs to take these courses?

You must enrol in one for these courses if you:

- started the BP221ACC 2.5 year accelerated program in July 2021 and don't have a course credit for Media 2
- failed a studio and need to repeat it

Those of you who don't fit into these categories might still like to consider doing a studio to lighten your study load in a future semester.

Which studios are running? How do I nominate my preference?

There will be between two to four studios offered (subject to enrolment numbers and funding), and each studio has a distinct theme. See the [media studio archive](#) for examples of studios offered previously, but please note that we usually change the overall line up of studios each new semester (and don't completely repeat all the previous year's offerings).

Allocation will be determined by a ballot process taking place in **Week 11 of semester two (from 4-7 October 2021)**. This process is separate to the timetabling preference system which is not used for studio allocation.

Students enrolled in the Spring-Flex Term courses specified above will be sent descriptions of the studios on Monday 4 October. This email will also include confirmation of the timetable for each studio.

You will be asked to nominate your studio preference via an electronic form. While we will do our best to accommodate your preferred option; however, **placement in your first preference cannot be guaranteed**.

Confirmation of your allocation will be emailed to you on Monday 11 October (and your allocation will be automatically entered in your timetable for you).

How do I enrol?

Log-in to Enrolment Online and then click 'enrol':

- Click on **UGRD Flexible Term 2021 - 'continue' icon**
- Click 'Year One' and then click the 'add' button to one of the course (see above) OR
- Add the course by entering the Class No (see above) into the 'Class Search' tab.

You can only enrol into one Media Studio course. Refer to your customised program map before enrolling to ensure you select the correct course.
