GET TO KNOW BLOCK - 101

MORNING TALKS - CRYPTO ALTRUISM AND SOCIAL INNOVATION

Novak will examine the use of blockchain technology as new economic infrastructure to reimagine the organisation and governance of coordinated altruism, including charities, not-for-profit organisations and civil society collectives.

Rennie will discuss how blockchain technology can enable social innovation and how it is being adopted into civil society organisations. Will explore how this is reshaping the way in which social impact is understood, measured, and evaluated.

PHILANTHROPY PANEL – TOWARD CHARITIES ON BLOCKCHAINS

This panel will discuss how charities, civil society organisations and philanthropists are currently viewing the opportunities that blockchain technology offers, the specific problems that the technology can solve, and the problems faced along the way.

AFTERNOON TALKS - BLOCKCHAIN AND PUBLIC FINANCE

By Sinclair Davidson and Jason Potts

Davidson will discuss how charities interact with governments via the tax concession and organisational licensing agreements, and how blockchain technology can change this relationship to incorporate new market based public finance possibilities (tax deduction markets and exclusive licensed mining).

Potts will present a model of how blockchain technology can be used to incentivise impact reporting (Impact coin), which provides a new level of accountability and transparency to those financing charities and not-for-profits.

PRESENTATION - REACHING BILLION THROUGH IMPACT INVESTING AND BLOCKCHAIN

Lina will discuss how financial market and the role of blockchain technology are to be utilised to democratising impact and helping for the bottom of the pyramid.

INDUSTRY PANEL - BLOCKCHAIN APPLICATIONS IN ORGANISATIONS

This panel will examine some particular use case applications, including in journalism and trust in news, radical transparency in project finance and management, and blockchain based solutions for public accountability and governance.

It will also discuss key developments and challenges in infrastructure, policy, risk and financial implications.
