How to write a review in OLIVER:

1. Login to OLIVER via your student portal
2. Search for the book you want to write a review for:
search via title or author, which ever you know!
3. Find the right catalogue record
4. Hover over the record
5. Click on Reader rating (0 reviews)
6. Click on the icon: top right corner
7. Type in your review
8. Click SAVE
