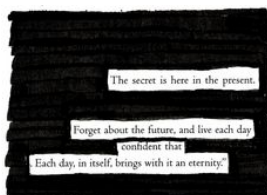
The Reading Hour:

1. Take a photo of your favourite reading place – mine’s in front of the fire at home –

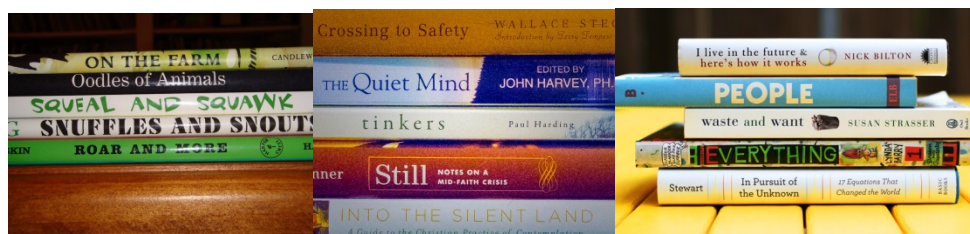


2. Create a blackout poem: create a poem by circling words within in a story or blacken out words in a story to create your own poem. –

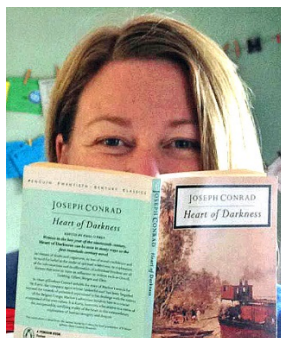


An Eternity - Blackout Poem by Kevin Harrell

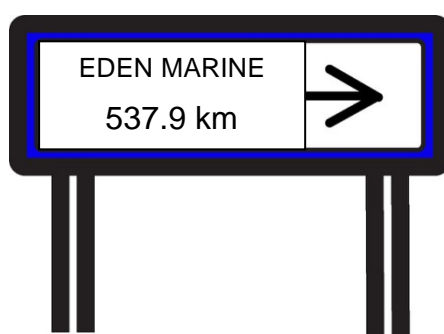
3. Use Spine titles: line up a group of book spines to tell a story –

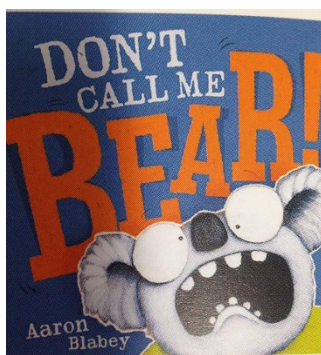
Meet Ellie and the team in the opening book of John Marsden's trilogy in seven parts.
