Visible Learning & Strategies for Maximum Impact – with John Hattie



Professional learning opportunity for rural and remote DoE schools in NSW

Topic: **Visible learning and strategies for maximum impact**

This professional learning session will address visible learning and evidence-based strategies for maximum impact on student learning. It will be presented by John Hattie, who synthesized the findings from 800 meta-analysis of 50,000 research studies involving more than 150 million students and built a story about the power of teachers and of feedback. He constructed a model of learning and understanding by pointing out what works best in improving student learning outcomes.

- Pre-session reading on visible learning and influences on student learning (30 mins)
- Live online session (75 mins) where teachers and leaders will:
 - Gain an understanding of the key findings and messages from the Visible Learning research
 - Learn about
 - the characteristics and actions of educators who are evaluators
 - the importance of developing the skill, will and thrill of learners and learning
 - the latest research on instructional strategies that considerably accelerate student learning
 - practices that can be implemented to know, understand and maximise teacher and school leader impact.
